Bullying Procedures for Bloomfield-Mespo Local Schools

- * All referrals are investigated by administrators
- * Referrals can be made by: students, parents, teachers, administrators, support Staff, and via school website
- * Parents will be notified during the investigation and if action is taken
- * Bully and victim meet separately with the school counselor
- * School counselor will monitor both bully and victim with documentation
- * Teachers are notified of potential bullying
- * Bully education will take place throughout the year
- * Bully definition posters will be placed around the building

Definition of bullying:

When someone says or does something intentionally hurtful and they keep doing it even when you tell them to stop or show them that you're upset.

Examples may include:

Name calling, hitting, using verbal taunts, spreading rumors, taking someone's property, making fun of people, embarrassing people, laughing at someone, shoving, putting people down, harassing someone, and picking on or attacking someone because they are different in some way, i.e. race, religion, gender, family background, etc..
