Thank you all for your cooperation, patience and support as we have returned to school this year. Thank you for following all of the safety guidelines and pandemic protocols, which has ensured a safe return to school.

Based on an administrative review and staff input over the past two weeks, the district will move to a one group of students Blended Learning plan starting on Monday, September 21. All district children are to attend school four days a week starting on Monday, September 21. Students will not attend school on Wednesdays. Children will be instructed remotely on Wednesdays. Wednesdays will continue to be used for additional cleaning, disinfecting and sanitation.

The district will continue to emphasize physical distancing, the wearing of face coverings, hygienic practices and individual health assessments. I need all of you involved in the education of our children to continue to cooperate and follow safety guidelines to ensure this change to the district blended learning plan.

We all have to be adaptable in the process of educating our children during this pandemic. We all must be flexible and ready to change to a different format of schooling as we respond to the uncertainty of living with the virus.

Again, the first day of changing to a four-day week of school for all children will be Monday, September 21st. Specific questions about this change in children's return to a four-day week should be directed to the building principal.
